



Seniors Festival Convict Precinct Tour: Terms and Conditions

Tour information:

Presented in the Convict Precinct, our knowledgeable guide will take you through the layered history of this one-time convict penal establishment, reformatory school and shipbuilding yard. Following the tour, there will be an opportunity for exploration of the upper island for those who are able, at their own pace.

These tours are ideal for all seniors interested in an immersive tour of our UNESCO world-heritage listed island. Ticketholders who are mobility impaired must purchase a 'mobility impaired ticket' for transportation by buggy to the upper island.

Check in:

Ensure you arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start time to check in for your tour.

Meeting Point:

- Mobility impaired – outside the Visitors Centre
- General admission – outside the Mess Hall

Tour conditions:

- These tours may involve a steep incline, some uneven surfaces and is not suitable for mobility scooters.
- Wear suitable walking shoes, and wet weather clothing if needed.
- Tours will proceed regardless of weather conditions except in cases of extreme weather. Participants will be notified if the tour is cancelled due to extreme weather.
- You must comply with all directions of the Guides, Rangers and Security.
- For safety reasons, maximum tour numbers cannot be exceeded.
- Dogs, bicycles and smoking are not allowed on the tour.
- Tour cancellations & transfers can be made up to seven (7) days prior to the tour date.
- The Harbour Trust reserves the right to terminate any tour at any time.
